

HARVEST OF QUILTS X

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

*Thank you for your interest in registering a quilt in the Country Quilters Guild Harvest of Quilts X.
The show will be held Saturday and Sunday, **September 25-26, 2010** from 10 AM to 4 PM
at the Pine Bush High School, Route 302 in Pine Bush, NY.*

Registration Instructions

You must submit a registration packet consisting of:

- completed registration form
- entry fee of **\$5 per quilt**; the check or money order must be made out to "Country Quilters Guild."
- labeled color 4" x 6" photograph for each quilt; quilt does not have to be finished in the photo.
- a self-addressed stamped business-size envelope which will be used to send your confirmation letter.

Please label your 4" x 6" color photograph with your name, quilt name, and quilt size. The photographs are used to design the exhibit and will **not** be returned at the end of the show.

Mailing address. Send the registration form, fee, photo and self-addressed stamped envelope to: Sharon Waddell, 443 Riley Road, New Windsor, NY 12553. **Registration must be received no later than August 27, 2010.**

Entry confirmation. Upon receipt and acceptance of your quilt registration packet we will send you a confirmation letter, delivery and pick-up instructions, and a numbered muslin label for each quilt.

Labels. All quilts must have a cloth address label sewn on the back of the quilt on the lower right hand corner as you look at the back of the quilt. The label must contain at a minimum your name, address and phone number. You will sew the registration number (which will be sent to you with your confirmation letter) over your label.

Sleeves. All quilts (except miniatures) must have a 4-inch wide sleeve attached to the top of the back. The sleeve should be close to the width of the quilt but must not be greater than 85"; if your quilt is wider than 85" please center the 85" sleeve on the back.

Condition. Quilts must be clean and free of damage. No unfinished quilts will be accepted for display. With the exception of vintage, children's, non-judged, or crazy quilts, no tied quilts will be accepted. Quilts may not be entered if they have been displayed previously in one of our quilt shows.

Insurance. All items should be covered under your home owner's insurance policy. Please contact your insurance company if you have questions or if your quilt is especially valuable. The CQG will take every reasonable precaution to safeguard quilts in their custody, but we can not be responsible for accidental damage/loss.

We reserve the right to change a quilt to a more appropriate category, reject a quilt, or limit the number of quilts displayed due to space limitations.

Quilt Delivery and Return

Delivery: All quilts must be received no later than Wednesday, **September 22, 2010**. On September 22 quilts may be delivered to guild representatives at Quilter's Attic on Route 302 in Pine Bush, NY between the hours of 10 AM and 3:30 PM. Please email or call if you need directions. If you wish to ship your quilt via mail or UPS, please notify us on your registration form by checking the block provided and we will send you shipping instructions.

Pick-up: All quilts must remain on display until the end of the quilt show. You may pick up your quilt at the show between 4:30 - 5:30 PM on Sunday, September 26, 2010. You **must** bring your claim ticket to receive your quilt. If you wish us to ship your quilt to you please notify us on your registration form by checking the block provided and we will send you instructions.

Is your quilt for sale? The Country Quilters Guild (CQG) will handle the sale of your quilt for a 10% commission fee. Indicate your sale price on your registration form. If your quilt is sold, a check for the sale proceeds minus commission will be sent to you after the show.

To simplify registration, you will NOT be asked to pick a category number. We will assign your quilt a category based on the information on your registration form and your quilt photo

Quilt categories are based on the size, construction, use, and type of quilting. Definitions:

Art Quilts: non-traditional original design, any size, or technique

Commercially quilted: person doing the quilting was paid for their service. If not paid, then the group quilt category should be used.

Clothing: jackets, coats, shirts, etc. that use the same techniques found in the other categories.

Display Only: quilt will not be judged

Embroidery Quilts: embroidery is the dominate design element.

Group Quilts: piecing, appliqué, and/or quilting done by more than one person, (i.e. block exchanges, family projects, friends, etc.)

Kit Quilts: fabric and pattern were provided. Kit quilts will be judged on workmanship only.

Large/Bed: sum of the measurements of all four sides is 240 inches or larger.

Medium/Wall hanging: sum of the measurements of all four sides is less than 240 inches.

Miniature: complete quilt in small scale and the perimeter is less than 97"

Mixed construction: both pieced and appliqué

QuiltSmart: commercial pre-printed fusible used as a pattern. Some patterns (i.e. double wedding ring) are mixed construction because they are both appliquéed and pieced using this technique.

Special Techniques or Use: yoyos, cathedral windows, crazy quilts, whole cloth quilts, table runners, placemats, pillows, purses, bags, etc.

Youth Quilts: any technique or size made by a child aged 14 or under.

Note: If the stated value of your quilt is greater than \$1,000, you must submit a copy of an appraisal with your registration form
